The equipment mechanic properly communicates any needs or problems relating to the maintenance or repair of equipment to the superintendent and/or the assistant superintendent, and schedules and directs the work assignments of the assistant equipment mechanic. The equipment mechanic places safety as a top priority and is responsible for maintaining a clean service area and maintenance building.
